

## **GVWG Outstanding Contribution Award – Terms of Reference**

There are people within any group that by their actions, leadership, guidance or hard work, significantly define the group. They are the ones without whom the group would undoubtedly be different. They are the ones whose contributions shape the group, give it direction, purpose, and richness. This award is intended to honour those people by:

- Recognizing them publicly at a regular meeting,
- Presenting them with an appropriate framed certificate,
- Making them a lifetime member of the GVWG.

### Nomination Process

Any member in good standing may be nominated for this award. Nomination forms must be signed by at least five members-in-good-standing and then forwarded to the Secretary for consideration by the currently sitting Board.

### Evaluation Process

The Board will consider each nomination and deliver an answer to the nominators in a timely manner. To be approved, 80% of the votes cast must be in favour of the nomination. The following criteria will be used:

- The contribution must be truly outstanding. For this reason the award is unlikely to be presented very often;
- The contribution must, in some way, have helped to shape the Guild;
- Long service (more than 10 years) may be considered an appropriate contribution;
- Current Board service should not be considered for this award.

### Presentation Ceremony

The Board will appoint a member to deliver the commendation and award at a regular Guild meeting. The commendation should include (but not be limited to) the reasons given in the nomination form.

The Board will use the following guidelines to determine if the award should be given:

- The contribution must be truly outstanding. For this reason the award is unlikely to be awarded very often;

- Long service (more than 10 years) may be considered an appropriate contribution;
- Nominee must be a member in good standing;
